



SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS PART ONE

Jacks Ridge Hillclimb Sunday 11th December 2022

1. JURISDICTION

This event is a Clubsport Advanced Status / Hillclimb Event, promoted by the South Auckland Car Club. The Meeting will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Five, Schedule C being the Standing Regulations for all ClubSport Events and Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

3. EVENT DESCRIPTION:

- **3.1** The event will be held at Jacks Ridge Whitford, consisting of approx 4.9 km of gravel road.
- **3.2 Classes:** Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:
 - (A) 0-1300
 - (B) 1301-1600
 - (C) 1601-2000
 - (D) 2001-over
 - (E) All 4WD

4. ENTRIES:

4.1 Entries must be made through the South Auckland Car Club Online system <u>www.sacc.co.nz</u> No Entries accepted on the day.

Any entry will not be deemed valid until payment is received.

Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

4.2 Opening and Closing Dates:

Entries open with the publication of these regulations and close on Friday 9th December at 1900hrs.

4.3 Entry Fees:

The Entry fee for this event is \$120.00, including GST per competitor.

4.4 Number of Starters: The maximum number of starters will be 50. Any additional entries received will be placed on the reserve list, or accepted at Organisers discretion.

5. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS and UNDERSTANDING:

5.1 Licence Requirements:

All drivers must hold as a minimum an M Grade Competition Licence and current membership with a member club.

If the Entrant is other than a driver, an Entrants licence in the name of the Entrant is required.

5.2 Competitor Understanding:

In submitting the entry competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In particular:

- The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and competitors obligations, and
- Appendix Five, Schedule C.
- 5.3 All competitors shall wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A.

6. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

6.1 Compliance: All vehicles shall comply with Appendix Five Schedule C and Appendix Two Schedule A of the current MotorSport Manual unless stated otherwise in these supplementary regulations.

6.2 ROLL PROTECTION is MANDATORY

7. DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION

- 7.1 **Documentation:** Will take place at The Venue, Jacks Ridge commencing at 0800 and concluding at 0930.
- **7.2** Scrutineering Audit Inspection: Will take place at the Venue, Jacks Ridge commencing a 0800 and concluding at 0900 Competitors will be advised at documentation if their vehicle has been selected for audit.
- **7.3 Drivers' Briefing:** This will be held at Jacks Ridge commencing at approximately 0930. Attendance by all drivers is compulsory a roll call will be taken and failure to attend will result in a penalty.

8. TIMING:

- 8.1 Timing will be by Electronic Light Start and Beam Finish
- **8.2** Competitors will start at 1 minute intervals where possible, with a 2 minute gap between Classes where necessary.
- **8.3** Results will be based on the fastest time during the day, for Class & Overall. There will be no eliminations

9. POSTPONEMENT CANCELLATION ABANDONMENT & ORGANISERS' RIGHTS:

9.1 Pursuant to national Sporting Code Article 13, the organisers reserve the right to cancel or postpone the event if less than 20 entries are received by the normal entry closing date.

10. OFFICIAL BULLETINS

10.1 Official Bulletins may be issued in accordance with the provisions of the National Sporting Code.

11. GENERAL INFORMATION

- **11.1 Passengers:** May only be carried in accordance with Appendix Five, Schedule C Article 6.2.
- **11.2** Alcohol is not permitted to be consumed by any competitor or their crew at the event before or during the day's competition.
